On behalf of the Board of Directors of the New York Thoroughbred Breeding and Development Fund, I am pleased to present this annual report for 2021. This report includes information on revenue, award payments, research funding, promotional spending and operational improvements made during the past year.

The state's Thoroughbred industry demonstrated single-mindedness of purpose in minimizing the effects of COVID-19 by encouraging vaccinations and masking protocols in offices and on farms. Racing fans were allowed back on track, and many who determined it was in their best interests to avoid public places stayed home and discovered the convenience of using remote wagering hubs.

The performances of registered New York-breds on racetracks and in sales pavilions demonstrate that the Fund is accomplishing its mission to "support by monetary incentives the responsible breeding of quality Thoroughbred racehorses in keeping with the founding legislation to preserve New York's irreplaceable farmland."

The award programs administered by the Fund are demonstrably encouraging people to breed, buy and race our homegrown product. The Fund is a pass-through organization that collects revenue from the racing industry and sends a minimum of 91% of that revenue back to stakeholders in the form of agricultural awards, purse enrichment for NY-breds and support for equine research. In short, the Fund contributes to the economic health of the state and its breeding and racing industries.

## **Executive Review**

To a great extent, New York racing and breeding recovered from the damage caused by COVID-19 during 2021, as revenues were restored to close to pre-pandemic levels, fans were allowed to attend races in person, and NY-breds distinguished themselves at the track and in the sales ring.

On the track, NY-breds proved once again that they can compete with the best. Just a year after Sackatoga Stable's New York-bred colt Tiz the Law won four Grade 1 stakes, including the Belmont and the Travers, China Horse Club and WinStar Farm's three-year-old New York-bred colt Americanrevolution captured the Grade 1 Cigar Mile against older horses, completing a sensational season for himself and for state-breds. It was the 12<sup>th</sup> year in a row that at least one NY-bred captured a stakes at the Grade 1 level.

NYRA, the Racetrack Chaplaincy of NY, NYTHA and others worked together to ensure that backstretch employees, jockeys and exercise riders were provided with vaccine protection against COVID-19. Fund employees all became vaccinated and practiced masking and social distancing when visiting our farms or working in the office to do our part to help return society to normal.

By mid-year, the Blood-Horse expressed confidence in New York racing, stating: "If there's at least one certainty in Thoroughbred racing, it's the enduring charm and allure of Saratoga Race Course. Not even a pandemic could change that." Bettors underscored the point by wagering a record-setting \$800 million-plus on the meet, proving that affection for the dowager of American tracks did indeed endure.

Significantly, a fresh face in the crowd cheered racing fans: Governor Kathy Hochul came to the track, handed out the Travers trophy and proclaimed herself a supporter of the industry that provides 19,000 jobs and more than \$3 billion to the state's economy.

Thirty New York-breds won more than \$200,000 in 2021 on the track, and Joe and Ann McMahon's New York stallion Central Banker emerged as one of the nation's best, ending the year as a top-ten dirt stallion in the U.S. Three Showcase Days exclusively for NY-breds, each offering more than a million dollars in purse money, underscored how important New York-breds are to the New York Racing Association.

Fasig-Tipton was able to hold both the August Preferred sale of NY-bred yearlings and its October mixed sale showcasing in-foal resident mares and NY-bred weanlings. Both had been cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020.

Notable benchmarks of the past year include:

- American revolution won the Grade 1 Cigar Mile against older horses.
- Five NY-breds scored graded stakes wins.
- NY-breds averaged \$28,563 per runner in North America and earned more than \$88 million in purses.
- NY-breds accounted for more than \$89.6 million in purse money worldwide.
- Significantly for breeders, \$66,760,300 was earned on tracks located in New York State.
- Auction revenue from NY-bred weanlings, yearlings and two-year-olds over the past decade more than tripled, from \$16.4 million in 2011 to nearly \$57 million in 2021.
- The NYTBDF was able to pay out 100% of the 2021 money held back from award earnings, doing so in the first week of January 2022.

- The Fund remained the main supporter of research conducted by the Zweig Fund via contribution of 2% of our total revenue.
- The 2021 foal crop of 1,492 was down only slightly from the 2020 figure and remains roughly 30 percent higher than the decade-low mark of 1,225 foals set in 2011.

#### **Stallions**

Forty-one stallions standing in New York were registered by the NY Thoroughbred Breeding and Development Fund in 2021. The following eight stallions were new to the state's roster:

- Fog of War
- Honest Mischief
- Killybegs Captain
- King for a Day
- Lookin At Lee
- Mr. Monomoy
- Name Changer
- Slumber (GB)

Breeders who use stallions standing in New York and registered with the NYS Thoroughbred Breeding and Development Fund are rewarded with double the awards earned by the offspring of non-registered stallions or stallions who stand in other states: 30% vs. 15% of first-place purse money. For second- and third-place finishes, NY-sired NY-breds receive 15% of purse money vs. 7.5% for the offspring of non-NY stallions. In all cases, the races must be run at tracks within New York State for awards to be generated.

### **Becoming a New York-Bred**

In order to encourage breeders to keep their mares and foals at New York State farms, the Fund has firm rules that must be followed to ensure that a foal that is dropped here is eligible to become a registered NY-bred. Breeders must make sure that their mares follow our residency rules, which necessitate that they submit mare movement information to help us establish compliance, allow their mares to be inspected by our registry compliance team, and in some cases breed their mare back to a registered New York stallion. It follows that only Thoroughbreds registered by the Fund by virtue of meeting the residency and inspection requirements can be entered in races restricted to NY-breds held at race meets conducted by the New York Racing Association and Finger Lakes Gaming and Racetrack. Similarly, only registered NY-breds can generate awards for their breeders and owners, as well as for the owners of registered New York stallions. NY-breds can also run in any "open" races in the state and throughout the world.

Current mare residency rules define a *resident mare* as one that is continuously in residence in New York State from date of conception in New York State or within **120 days** after her last cover in the year of conception occurring outside of New York State, and remains in the State until foaling the following year, with no breedback required. Mares that maintain their New York State resident status can be covered each season by a stallion located anywhere in the world.

A non-resident mare is a mare that does not qualify as a resident mare. However, under the new rules, a non-resident mare purchased in foal through public auction will be deemed to be a resident mare for all purposes if all of the following conditions are satisfied: (1) the mare is purchased for at least \$50,000 at public auction; (2) the mare is present in New York State within 15 days after the sale is concluded; (3) the mare foals in New York State; and (4) the mare thereafter is continuously in residence in New York State from within 120 days

after her last cover in the year of conception of another foal and remains in residency until having a second New York foal.

#### Revenue

The total operating revenues of \$19,965,380 in 2021 represents an increase of \$8,263,876 from 2020 revenues. The increase in 2021 was due to an increase in Fund revenue from VLTs (\$7.1M) and handle (\$1.2M).

It should be noted that in 2014 VLT revenues from Resort World Casino in Aqueduct and Finger Lakes Gaming and Racetrack accounted for approximately 64% of the Fund's total operating revenues, whereas in 2021 their contribution to revenue dropped to 46%. Due to the addition of a VLT recapture beginning in 2016, the Fund was able to recognize additional revenues of \$2.4M in 2021, which increased the percentage of revenues generated from all VLT revenue sources to 65% of total operating revenues.

#### **Awards and Purse Enrichment**

#### **Awards**

Breeders, owners and stallion owners earned \$15,867,958 in awards in 2021.

#### **Purse Enrichment**

The Fund supplied \$1,782,791 in purse enrichment to NYRA and Finger Lakes Gaming and Racetrack in 2021.

### **Equine Research**

The annual contribution of 2% the NY Thoroughbred Breeding and Development Fund's revenue to the Harry M. Zweig Fund at Cornell University makes the Fund the largest single contributor to the research group. The 2021 payment of \$399,308 to the Harry M. Zweig Fund supported research into issues such as the causes and possible cures for equine respiratory and influenza problems, colic in foals, embryonic stem cell research, and mapping the horse genome.

### **Other Highlights**

This report highlights NY-bred accomplishments on the racetrack and in the sales ring, and also provides a detailed accounting of the receipts and disbursements in the Fund's three incentive areas – breeder awards, stallion awards, and open-company owner awards.

Additionally, it contains an analysis of the impact of the New York State Thoroughbred breeding program. Also included is a brief review of the Fund's promotional and aftercare efforts.

## Financial Review

Under founding statutes, the Fund receives revenue from on-track and off-track Thoroughbred handle in New York, and breakage from regional off-track wagers. Total handle accounted for 23 percent and 30 percent of operating revenue in 2021 and 2020, respectively, while breakage accounted for 2 percent and 2.5 percent of operating revenue for 2021 and 2020, respectively.

The Fund obtained an additional contractual source of revenue from Video Lottery Terminals (VLTs) at Finger Lakes Gaming and Racetrack beginning in 2004, which provided approximately 7 percent and 5 percent of total operating revenue for 2021 and 2020, respectively. Further enhancing Fund revenues, Resorts World Casino New York City began operation of VLTs at Aqueduct Racetrack in late 2011. Statutory revenue received from this operation was approximately \$9.1 million in 2021 and \$4.1 million in 2020, or 46 percent and 35 percent of total operating revenue, respectively. The VLT recapture for 2021 of \$2.4 million allows the Fund to maintain 2013 Resorts World VLT revenue levels adjusted for inflation, and resulted in a 65 percent combined percentage from all VLT revenue sources in 2021 versus 50 percent in 2020, when casino and track closings caused by the COVID-19 pandemic sharply reduced revenue.

Effective January 1, 2014, legislation provided for the Fund to receive revenues from Advanced Deposit Wagering (ADW) sources. Total ADW revenue accounted for 9 percent and 16 percent of total operating revenue for 2021 and 2020, respectively.

The total 2021 operating revenue of approximately \$20 million was \$8 million higher than the 2020 figure. The Fund was able to pay out 100% of all breeder, stallion and owner awards earned in 2021. The Fund also authorized a 13% supplemental award to all 2021 award earners and \$200,000 in purse enrichment specifically to support the New York Stallion Stakes Series conducted by the New York Racing Association.


By closely monitoring administration and promotional expenses, the Fund was able to remain below the statutory spending caps of 5 percent and 6 percent, respectively, in 2021. Administration expenses of \$892,041 represented 4.5 percent of total operating revenues in 2021. Promotional expenses of \$1,107,718 represented 5.5 percent of 2021 total operating revenues, and includes \$157,000 in promotional support for aftercare facilities in New York approved by the Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance (thoroughbredaftecare.org)


Statutes dictate that the Fund pays the Harry M. Zweig Memorial Fund of Cornell University 2 percent of its operating revenues to fund equine research. The amount payable to Cornell University for 2021 is \$399,308. This is a \$165,278 increase from 2020.








#### **Ten-Year History of Awards**

# Mares & Foals

#### **Mares & Foals Report**

The 2021 New York foal crop of 1492 foals represents a 3.68% decline from the state's previous year's figure of 1,549, marking the third year in a row in which fewer foals were born in the state. However, in the context of the disruptions caused by the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020 (when these foals were conceived) and 2021, these numbers are surprisingly strong. They are a testament to the ingenuity and tenacity of New York's breeders, who worked overtime to keep their breeding programs on track during such difficult times.

The 2021 crop also remains over 20% higher than the pre-VLT low of 1,225 foals in 2011. The desire to increase the size of the state's foal crop was one of the reasons the Fund board made changes to the breed-back rules in late 2020. 




#### **Active New York State Farms**




#### **Mares Bred**




### Mares Bred to Registered NY Stallions and Mares Bred Out-of-State (incl. Non-Reg. NY Stallions)




### **NY Foal Crop**

### Stallion Report

A Grade 2 stakes winner and earner of nearly \$600,000 in just 13 starts – posting four victories, three seconds and two thirds - **Central Banker** has emerged as the top stallion in New York State for Joe and Anne McMahon's McMahon of Saratoga Thoroughbreds. Central Banker's progeny had a great year in 2021, posting progeny earnings of \$4,155,215, good enough to rank 67<sup>th</sup> nationally. Bank On Shea, Bank Sting and Central Banker's first million-dollar earner Bankit fashioned their sire's best year, and Bank Sting added a neck victory in the \$97,000 La Verdad Stakes at Aqueduct on January 2<sup>nd</sup>, suggesting even better results to come.

"Horses that are extremely well-balanced like Central Banker can go with a lot of different types of mares," Mr. McMahon said. "They can overcome a lot of different types of problems if they give their offspring that balance. That's what he did and that's what we hoped he would do when we bought him."

Five other New York-bred stallions ranked in the top 150 nationally in progeny earnings: Irish Hill & Dutchess Views' **Big Brown** was 87<sup>th</sup>, Sequel Stallions New York's **Freud** finished 94<sup>th</sup>, Waldorf Farm's **Bustin Stones** was 138<sup>th</sup>, narrowly ahead of the pensioned **Bellamy Road** (142<sup>nd</sup>) and Irish Hill & Dutchess Views' **War Dancer** (143<sup>rd</sup>).

**Union Jackson**, who stands at Sequel Stallions New York, finished 30<sup>th</sup> among first-crop sires with \$254,295 in progeny earnings. Monhill Farm's **Bethel** checked in 59<sup>th</sup>.

The highest national finish in any stallion group was achieved by War Dancer, who ranked 14<sup>th</sup> among second-crop sires with his \$1,869,238 in progeny earnings. The late hard-hitter **Effinex** finished 25<sup>th</sup>, followed by Rockridge Stud's **Slumber (GB)** (36<sup>th</sup>), Buckridge Farm's **Beautyinthepulpit** (70<sup>th</sup>), Mill Creek Farm's **Tencendur** (89<sup>th</sup>) and Foggy Bottom Farm's **Scatman** (90<sup>th</sup>).


**Majestic City**, another stallion standing at Irish Hill and Dutchess Views, ranked 31<sup>st</sup> among third-crop sires nationally with \$828,408 in progeny earnings. The pensioned **Micromanage** finished 33<sup>rd</sup>, followed by Majestic View Farms International's **Hangover Kid** (55<sup>th</sup>), Rockridge Farm's **Al Khali** (58<sup>th</sup>) and Majestic View Farm International's Make Reservations (71<sup>st</sup>).

Among sires of two-year-olds, Freud finished 78<sup>th</sup> with \$650,928 in earnings. Central Banker ranked 95<sup>th</sup> and Big Brown was 108<sup>th</sup>.

In addition to Hangover Kid, joining New York's stallion roster in 2022 are Combatant, Galilean, Joevia, Son of Thunder, Venezuelan Hug and Waiting.

# New York-Bred Auction Summary

#### **NY-BREDS AT AUCTION: 2021**

The world continues to emerge from the setbacks caused by the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, including a resilient North American Thoroughbred industry that looked more and more like it did in 2019 with each passing day in 2021. North America's bloodstock markets realized significant gains during the year, after taking some serious lumps in 2020 as a result of the pandemic, and New York played a key role.

The New York-bred bloodstock market rebounded with authority in 2021, realizing gains in every major metric as auction schedules returned to normal. The largest segment of the New York-bred industry – yearling sales – flourished in 2021 after sharp declines in 2020 that followed a seven-year stretch of robust results.

Sales of New York-bred **yearlings** increased by 75.5%, from \$18,987,400 in 2020 to \$33,327,200 in 2021. Bolstered by the return of several important yearling sales to the calendar – notably the Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Select, Fasig-Tipton Saratoga New York-bred and Fasig-Tipton Kentucky July auctions – breeders and sellers welcomed the opportunity to present their crops to the public. The number of New York-bred yearlings sold in 2021 increased by 27.4%, from just 416 in 2020 (the smallest number since 2012) to a near-record 530.

Almost 40% of the New York-bred yearlings sold in 2021 went through the Saratoga sales ring as part of the aforementioned New York-bred sale, which saw 203 bring more than \$18.5 million, for an average price of \$91,461 and a median of \$70,000. The sales of those yearlings, along with 19 that brought \$100,000 or more at the Keeneland September sale, helped drive the average price for the year to \$62,882. That was the second-highest in history, representing a 37.8% increase from the average of \$45,643 in 2020, and was also up 9.2% from the \$57,584 figure in 2019. The median for New York-bred yearlings also rose 20% to \$30,000, the best since 2018 and third-highest in history.

New York-bred Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Sprint winner Bar of Gold did herself, breeders Chester and Mary Broman, and seller Sequel New York one better when she produced the most expensive New York-bred sold at public auction for the second straight year. A year removed from her Tapit colt bringing \$450,000, a colt from the first crop of Triple Crown winner Justify out of Bar of Gold landed a final bid of \$825,000 at the Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Select Sale.

The second most expensive New York-bred yearling in 2021 was a colt by City of Light out of the Mr. Greeley mare Gracilia that brought \$650,000 at the Keeneland September sale. Bred by Anlyn Farms, the colt had previously sold as a weanling for \$235,000 in 2020.

The sales of those high-priced yearlings and others pushed gross receipts for New York-breds over the \$30 million mark for just the second time in history, trailing only the record of \$33,534,737 for 495 sold in 2018.

Sales of New York-bred **two-year-olds** enjoyed a similar rebound. After falling to levels not seen since the early to middle 2010s, results returned to those seen during the steady three-year run of growth from 2017 to 2019. Overall, 256 New York-bred juveniles sold for \$17,656,200, an increase of 55.5% from the \$11,354,922 gross for the 223 sold in 2020. Last year's total receipts were also the third-highest in history, trailing only the \$19,005,997 in 2019 and \$18,171,700 in 2018.

Gains were also seen in the number sold (up 14.8%), average price (\$68,970; up 35.5% and third-highest in history) and median (\$30,000; up 20%).

A colt by Connect bred by Hidden Lake Farm and South Elkhorn commanded the highest price for a New York-bred two-year-old at public auction in 2021, bringing \$685,000 from Stonestreet Stables at the OBS April sale. The colt, now named Relate, originally sold for \$100,000 as a weanling at the 2019 Fasig-Tipton Saratoga fall mixed sale. Relate wound up one of 20 two-year-olds that sold for six-figure prices at the OBS April sale. A total of 54 New York-bred two-year-olds sold for \$100,000 or more at the three main OBS juvenile sales and the two Fasig-Tipton juvenile sales.

Sales of New York-bred **weanlings** enjoyed the highest year-over-year percentage increase in 2021. After being hit with an almost 50% drop in 2020 due to the pandemic, and with 116% more weanlings sold (136 compared to 63), sales of weanlings rose 115.9% in 2021, to \$5,818,100. The average price of a New York-bred weanling increased from \$40,744 in 2020 to \$42,7780 in 2021, the best since 2018 and third-highest in history.

New York-bred sales statistics are based on data from The Jockey Club. National sales statistics are derived from the BloodHorse 2021 Auction Digest. Statistics from Keeneland, Fasig-Tipton and OBS are based on company data.

# New York-Breds at the Races

For the second straight year, a three-year-old New York-bred son of Constitution stepped into a national spotlight with a Grade 1 victory. One year after Sackatoga Stable's brilliant Tiz the Law won the Grade 1 2020 Florida Derby, Belmont Stakes and Travers easily before finishing second in the Grade 1 Kentucky Derby to Authentic, CHC Inc. and WinStar Farm's **Americanrevolution** followed a sensational 11 ¾-length victory against older New York-breds in the \$300,000 Empire Classic with a game half-length victory against opencompany older horses in the \$750,000 Grade 1 Cigar Mile at Aqueduct on December 4<sup>th</sup>. Americanrevolution, out of the Super Saver mare Polly Freeze, was bred by Fred Hertich III and John D. Fielding.

New York-breds scaling those lofty heights isn't so much revolution as it is evolution.

"We've seen it time and time again with Funny Cide, Tiz the Law, and now Americanrevolution," Ameicanrevolution's Hall of Fame trainer Todd Pletcher said. "Horses born in New York can compete with anybody."

They didn't take long to prove it in open-company stakes in 2021. On January 23<sup>rd</sup>, Chester and Mary Broman's popular homebred **Mr. Buff** took the \$100,000 Jazil Stakes at Aqueduct for trainer John Kimmel. Mr. Buff is the 27<sup>th</sup> all-time New York-bred earner with \$1,396,536.

On May 15<sup>th</sup> at Pimlico Race Course, Skychai Racing and David Koenig's hard-hitting **Somelikeithotbrown** captured the \$250,000 Grade 2 Dinner Party Stakes.

Bond Racing Stable's **Rinaldi** won the \$100,000 Grade 3 Forbidden Apple Stakes at Saratoga on July 16<sup>th</sup>. The son of Posse out of the Dynaformer mare Dynamite Cocktail was bred by Barry Ostrager and is trained by Jim Bond.

Fifteen days later at Saratoga, Three Diamond Farms' **Cross Border** won the \$200,000 Grade 2 Bowling Green for trainer Michael Maker. Berkshire Stud and B. D. Gibbs bred the grass star.

Another Chester and Mary Broman homebred, **Coinage**, co-owned by D.J. Stable, captured the \$150,000 Grade 3 With Anticipation Stakes at Saratoga for trainer Mark Casse on September 1<sup>st</sup>.

Through the year, New York-breds won stakes at Aqueduct, Belmont Park, Colonial Downs, Delaware Park, Fair Hill, Finger Lakes, Laurel, Monmouth Park, Pimlico, Presque Isle, Saratoga Race Course, the Tryon International Equine Center in North Carolina, Turfway Park and Woodbine.

Thirty-three New York-breds topped \$200,000 in earnings last year, led by Americanrevolution, who made \$941,760. An additional 20 New York-breds topped \$170,000 in earnings.

New York-bred success wasn't limited to the racetrack. **Central Banker**, who stands at McMahon of Saratoga Thoroughbreds, had progeny earnings of \$4,155,215 to finish 66<sup>th</sup> nationally.

"I think the New York-bred program is the best in the country for owners and for breeders and for the industry," Terry Finley, founder and CEO of West Point Thoroughbreds, said. "They have been innovative. I think it shows."

That innovation is manifest in the three showcase days, featuring entire cards of New York-bred races including multiple stakes, and the New York Stallion Stakes Series (for the offspring of NY stallions foaled anywhere), which offered two half-million-dollar purses in December, both won by New York-breds.

The best New York-bred in 2021 was American revolution, who sold for \$275,000 at the Saratoga August Yearling Sale in 2019.

Originally trained by Rodolphe Brissset, American revolution made just one start as a two-year-old, rallying to finish fourth in an open six-furlong maiden special weight at Keeneland on October 24<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

He then had the good fortune to join Todd Pletcher's stable in New York. Pletcher trained Ameicanrevolution's dam's sire, 2007 Kentucky Derby winner Super Saver. "Americanrevolution started once before in Kentucky and he showed ability," Pletcher said. "It made sense to get him to New York. He trained really well. He indicated in his training that he wanted to go longer."

Making his three-year-old debut at Belmont Park on June 20<sup>th</sup>, 2021, Americanrevolution withstood pressure the whole way to win a six-furlong New York-bred maiden special weight by a neck under Luis Saez, who rode the colt in all of his three-year-old starts.

Pletcher saw enough to up the ante, entering American revolution in the \$150,000 mile-and-a-sixteenth New York Derby at Finger Lakes on July 19<sup>th</sup>. In his first start in a route race, American revolution rolled by 7 ½ lengths.

He followed that outstanding performance with a five-length romp in the \$250,000 mile-and-an-eighth Albany Stakes at Saratoga on Showcase Day August 27<sup>th</sup>.

"We were at a crossroads," Pletcher said. "That's when we decided to take a shot in the Pennsylvania Derby. That was a lot to ask, going against Triple Crown contenders." Americanrevolution finished third, 6 ¾ lengths behind the accomplished Hot Rod Charlie. "What I really liked about that race was he continued and ran hard to the wire, even though he was behind that group in experience," Pletcher said.

Next up was the \$300,000 Empire Classic on Showcase Day October 30<sup>th</sup> at Belmont Park. Sent off the 2-5 favorite in his first start on a sloppy track, American evolution dominated, winning by 11 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> lengths.

"He ran his best race that day," Pletcher said. "He put that field away. We said, 'What do we do now?' We focused on the Cigar Mile."

That meant taking on older, open horses. Showing a ton of class, American revolution rallied to a half-length victory. "To win a Grade 1 was huge for him and his stallion career," Pletcher said.

Americanrevolution will get more Grade 1 opportunities in 2022. "He's being freshened at WinStar now," Pletcher said in December. "We're looking at the Whitney, those kind of races. We hope we make it to the Breeders' Cup Classic."

A New York-bred in the Breeders' Cup Classic? It's no longer a revolution.

Two vastly different horses finished second and third in New York-bred earnings in 2021. Skychai Racing and David Koenig's five-year-old Somelikeithotbrown, the son of 2008 Kentucky Derby and Preakness Stakes winner Big Brown out of Marilyn Monroan by Tapit, had two victories, two seconds and one third in six starts, good for \$498,000 in earnings. Besides the Grade 2 Dinner Party Stakes at Pimlico, he captured the \$200,000 Mohawk Stakes for New York-breds at Belmont Park. He was only beaten a half-length when second in the Grade 2 Wise Dan Stakes at Churchill Downs, and he then finished a solid third by two lengths in the Grade 1 Keeneland Turf Mile. In between those two races, he ran second in the Grand 3 Mint Million at Kentucky Downs. His career earnings are \$1,189,338 thanks to eight victories, six seconds and three thirds in 23 starts for trainer Mike Maker, making Somelikeithotbrown the  $42^{nd}$  all-time leading New York-bred in earnings.

Cross Border, one of the top turf horses in the country the last three years, finished a solid seven-year-old season by winning the Prairie Bayou Stakes at Turfway Park on December 18<sup>th</sup>, pushing his 2021 earnings to \$416,708, third highest among New York-breds. He had two victories, one second and three thirds in nine starts, upping his career earnings to \$1,087,925, good for 49<sup>th</sup> all-time among state-breds.

A pair of Reeves Thoroughbred Racing two-year-old stars finished fourth and fifth in earnings.

**Dakota Gold** made just three starts in 2021, yet earned \$385,000. After winning an open maiden special weight at Saratoga, he added the \$500,000 Nownownow Stakes by 2 ½ lengths at Monmouth Park. Sent off the 5-2 favorite in the Grade 1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Stakes at Del Mar, he finished fifth by 2 ¼ lengths. Sequel Thoroughbreds and Ron Bowden bred the son of Freud out of Dakota Kid, a daughter of Belmont Stakes and Travers Stakes winner Lemon Drop Kid. Danny Gargan is his trainer.

Reeves' **Senbei** (\$364,857) wasn't far behind thanks to four victories and one second in five starts. Co-owned by Darlene Bilinski and bred by her husband Dr. Jerry Bilinski, Senbei captured three stakes: the Funny Cide on Showcase Day at Saratoga, the New York Breeders' Futurity at Finger Lakes, and the Notebook Stakes at Aqueduct. His lone loss was a second-place finish in another New York-bred stakes. He is trained by Christophe Clement.

Completing the Top Ten in earnings were **Geno** (\$337,250); **Make Mischief** (\$327,600); **Bank Sting** (\$321,300), who was five-for-six on the year; **Maiden Beauty** (\$310,280); and **Shipsational** (\$278,750), who was three-for-four.

Mandham Racing Stable's Geno, bred by Pete Martine and is trained David Donk, won two of four starts, including the \$500,000 Great White Way Division of the New York Stallion Stakes Series on December 18<sup>th</sup> at Aqueduct, with one third-place finish.

Avanti Stable bred Gary Barber's Make Mischief, who posted three victories, including in the Maddie Stakes at Aqueduct, with one second and three third-place finishes.

Joe and Anne McMahon's homebred Bank Sting, co-bred by Hidden Brook Farm and trained by John Terranova, was good all year long, taking the Critical Eye Stakes on the first Showcase Day May 31<sup>st</sup> and a division of the New York Stallion Stakes Series on December 5<sup>th</sup>.

Maiden Beauty had five victories, including the Bay Ridge Stakes at Aqueduct on December 30<sup>th</sup>, three seconds and one third in 10 starts for John Grossi's Racing Corp. Sandy Glenn Stable bred the filly.

Iris Smith Stable's Shipsational, bred by Mr. and Mrs. Bert Firestone, won three of four starts including the Bertram Bongard and the Sleepy Hollow Stakes for trainer Ed Barker.

Another 23 New York-breds earned more than \$200,000 last year: Yo Cuz, Tiergan, My Boy Tate, Time Limit, The King Cheek, Runaway Rumour, Bankit, Scuttlebuzz, Venti Valentine, Betsy Blue, Cold Hard Cash, The Important One, Lobsta, Byhubbyhellomoney, Robin Sparkles, Awesome Debate, Wild Banker, Shaker Shack, Sport Model, Sea Foam, Coinage, Ice Princess and Sharp Starr.

The New York Racing Association held 18 stakes on the three Showcase Days, May 31<sup>st</sup> at Belmont Park, August 27<sup>th</sup> at Saratoga and October 30<sup>th</sup> at Belmont, and the lone New York-bred to win two of them was American revolution.

Bankit, Betsy Blue, Bank Sting, Robin Sparkles, **Vintage Hollywood** and **River Dog** won Showcase stakes on May 31<sup>st</sup>.

Bankit won two of five starts with two seconds, one third and earnings of \$241,200 for owners Winchell Thoroughbreds and Willie Horton Racing, breeders Hidden Brook Farm and Blue Devil Racing, and trainer Steve Asmussen. With career earnings of \$1,027,875, he is 58<sup>th</sup> all-time among New York-breds.

Cloud Nine Stable's Betsy Blue, bred by Blue Devil Racing Stables and trained by Linda Rice, was ultra-consistent, hitting the board in all nine starts, with four wins, four seconds, one third and earnings of \$225,500. Robin Sparkles was in the money in all but one of her seven starts, with three wins, one second and two thirds for owner Michael Schrader and trainer Bruce Brown. Hibiscus Stables bred the filly. She earned \$215,505 in 2021.

Noda Brothers LLC's Vintage Hollywood, bred by Harry Landry and trained by Orlando Noda, and Robert Hahn's homebred River Dog, trained by Jeremiah Englehart, also won Showcase Day stakes on May 31<sup>st</sup>.

Besides Americanrevolution and Senbei, Byhubbyhellomoney, **Giacosa**, **City Man** and **November Rein** won Showcase stakes at Saratoga on August 27<sup>th</sup>.

Jupiter Stable's Byhubbyhellomoney, bred by Anderson Boulton Thoroughbreds, had two wins, two seconds and two thirds in eight starts, for 2021 earnings of \$218,050.

Bond Racing Stable's Giacosa, trained by Jim Bond, made the most of six starts with two victories, two seconds and one third, earning \$193,950. She was bred by Song Hill Thoroughbreds and Roderick Towle.

Reeves Thoroughbreds had another major winner in City Man, co-owned by Peter and Patty Searles. He had one victory, taking the West Point Stakes, with two seconds and two thirds, earning \$182,550 for trainer Christophe Clement. City Man was bred by Moonstar Farm.

Mr. Amore Stables' November Rein made the most of four starts in 2021, with two victories, one second and \$177,750 in earnings for trainer Kelly Breen. Ron Lombardi bred November Rain.

Joining American revolution as winner of the final Showcase Day on October 30th were Venti Valentine, The Important One, Sharp Starr, **Ny Traffic** and **Shesawildjoker**.

NY Final Furlong Racing Stable's homebred Venti Valentine, co-owned by Parkland Thoroughbreds and co-bred by Maspeth Stable, had a great year in 2021 with two victories, including in the Maid of the Mist Stakes, and one second in three starts, earning \$228,750. Jorge Abreu trained the two-year-old filly.

Bloom Racing Stable's homebred The Important One earned \$220,675 from three wins and a pair of thirds in eight starts for trainer Steve Asmussen.

Barry Schwartz's homebred Sharp Starr's one victory in seven starts was the right one, in the Empire Distaff Handicap. She also had one second and two thirds, earning \$201,280 for the year.

The uptick in handle that began during 2020 continued into 2021, with on-track attendance being allowed at NYRA and Finger Lakes, and evidence suggests that many people who discovered remote wagering on horses during the pandemic continued to place wagers through online venues in 2021. NYRA reported a record-high handle of \$2.3 billion, which was an increase of 12.6% over 2019, the last year not affected by COVID-related shutdowns. NYRA treats wagers placed through NYRABets as on-track handle, so the Fund did benefit from those wagers but does not share in NYRA's other simulcast revenue. Additionally, the figures reported by NYRA show an actual decline in on- track wagers between 2019 (\$310,053,754) and 2021 (\$266,978,634).

The incentives provided by New York's Thoroughbred Breeding and Development Fund, coupled with the high purses at NYRA tracks and plentiful restricted racing opportunities for registered NY-breds, continued to make the New York program the envy of other states in 2021. The Fund responded to increased competition for the broodmares so critical to foal-crop size by maintaining changes made to mare residency requirements in late 2020 (details can be found at NYBreds.com).

### Indiana

For the second year in a row, the Indiana Thoroughbred Breed Development Program offered incentives worth up to \$2,000 for new mares foaling in the state. To be eligible for an incentive of \$1,000, an in-foal mare due to foal in 2021 had to be purchased at public auction for a minimum purchase price of \$5,000. The new owner had to provide proof of purchase and the mare could not have been previously registered with the Indiana Thoroughbred Breed Development Program. Further, the mare had to be registered with the Indiana Horse Racing Commission prior to foaling, and had to foal in Indiana and remain in the state for at least 30 days after foaling. The owner was eligible to collect an additional \$1,000 incentive by breeding the mare back to a stallion registered with the Indiana Horse Racing Commission, returning to foal in Indiana in 2022, and registering that foal with the IHRC.

Additionally, Indiana boasted that it ran 400 restricted races during the year, paid out a record amount of breeder awards (\$3.27 million), offered a record amount of purse money at Indiana Grace Racetrack (\$36 million) and built a new 100-stall barn and a 50-room dormitory for backstretch workers.

### **Kentucky**

Kentucky lawmakers moved to protect the golden goose known as Historical Horse Racing (HHR) by legalizing the slots-like games, which a State Supreme Court had declared unconstitutional in September 2020 because it didn't meet the definition of pari-mutuel wagering. HHR results are based on "disconnected, randomly selected, historical horse races."

The move protects the generous revenue stream that allows Kentucky to offer the richest daily purse structure in the nation. HHR is also praised for contributing billions to the state's economic development, agribusiness and tourism in the state.

Additionally, Kentucky is considering allowing \$5 to \$10 million in funds from the Kentucky Thoroughbred Development Fund (KTDF) to bolster awards in claiming races. They say the expense will be more than offset by increased revenue from Historical Horse Racing.

## Maryland

The Maryland Horse Breeders Association announced new incentives to lure mare owners to Maryland farms and court stallions for the state.

First, beginning in 2022 there will be an additional 10% breeder bonus (for a total of 40% to all Maryland-sired and Maryland-bred maiden winners in MD).

Second, starting with Maryland-bred foals of 2023, there will be a tiered breeder bonus system that rewards the state-bred offspring of Maryland sires.

- 35% breeder bonus to Maryland-bred foals sired by a Maryland sire
- 25% breeder bonus to Maryland-breds finishing 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in all overnight races

Also, starting in January of 2022 the bonus percentages for all stakes in Maryland (except for Maryland Million Day) will be 30% for breeder 10% for stallion owners for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>-place finishes.

Unfortunately, the biggest challenge faced by the state's racing industry during the year were the 18 fatalities at Laurel Park that caused officials to cancel many race days as they looked into whether the racetrack conditions contributed to the breakdowns. In November, several fatalities occurred in mid-stretch during workouts or racing, and that's where officials and consultants concentrated their efforts. The main track at Laurel had been replaced in April when it had become apparent that cushion repairs made over the winter were not satisfactory. Reporter Frank Vespe noted that the first day of racing in December that followed the repairs played fairly, but that times were slower due to the fact that the dirt was deeper on the racing surface. Track superintendents, take note.

### **Ontario**

The Ontario Thoroughbred Improvement Program believes its incentives to attract mares and stallions to the province are working. The TIP points to 2021 improvements in three categories:

- Live foals increased by 2.4%
- Registered stallions increased by 12.5%
- Mares bred increased by 13.9%

From the Ontario Racing website: The Thoroughbred MPP (Mare Purchase Program) is eligible to purchasers, who are Ontario residents.

The MPP applies to in-foal mares with progeny of 2022 purchased at one of the following 2021-2022 Ontario Racing recognized public auctions — Wannamaker's Online Sale, Fasig-Tipton November Breeding Stock Sale, Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale, Keeneland January Horses of All Ages Sale, OBS Winter Mixed Sale, Fasig-Tipton Midlantic Winter Mixed Sale and Fasig-Tipton Kentucky Winter Mixed Sale. RNA's will not be eligible; must be a bona fide sale. Mares purchased online through any of the above recognized sales will be accepted.

Purchasers receive 50% of the purchase price, up to a maximum of \$25,000 CAD. In-foal mares must be purchased for a minimum purchase price of \$10,000 USD, with no maximum. There is a capped maximum distribution of \$75,000 CAD to any one individual, partnership, corporation or other ownership group. There is an added \$2,500 CAD incentive for every mare bred back to a registered Ontario sire during the 2022 breeding season, paid upon declaration of live foal with the Jockey Club. The total funding for this program is \$500,000 CAD and will be paid on a "first-come, first-served basis."

### Pennsylvania

The PA breeding program is funded by one-percent of handle. The state's breeding program pays 40% awards to PA-sired PA-breds for first- through third-place finishes. This mimics the NY program, which offers double awards to NY-sired award earners. In June, the Pennsylvania Horse Breeders Association announced that the pandemic would not the affect award rate.

Pennsylvania allocates up to 12% of slots tax funding to the Race Horse Development Fund, which pays for purses, breeder incentives, drug testing and enforcement activities, according to Education Voters of Pennsylvania. An education group in 2021 commissioned a poll that concluded taxpayers would prefer to end support for horse racing and breeding, and would prefer to provide free college education at state schools. The PA Equine Coalition points out that support for the industry does not come from tax payers, but rather from casinos and track owners. The horse racing industry is estimated to support some 20,000 jobs in the Keystone State.



# Promotion & Advertising Report

Advertising dollars in 2021 were spent promoting the benefits NY-breds receive as a result of the awards provided by the NY Thoroughbred Breeding and Development Fund, the opportunities to race in restricted state-bred races offering purses enhanced by purse enrichment provided by the Fund, and ads to spread the word about new mare residency rules aimed at recruiting quality mares to the state.

First and foremost, the Fund provided commercials and video content to NYRA that were aired on Fox Sports, which carried racing from Aqueduct, Belmont and Saratoga. NYRA President and CEO David O'Rourke noted that Fox Sports "has quickly become the year-round home of the finest Thoroughbred racing in the country." Early in 2022, NYRA announced that beginning in 2023 the Belmont Stakes, third leg of the Triple Crown, will move from NBC to Fox under a contract that extends through 2030. Viewers learned about registered NY stallions, breeding farms that produce NY-breds, and the accomplishments of NY-breds in the auction ring.

Print ads promoted outstanding performances by NY-breds and educated breeders about the new more-permissive mare residency rules.

Since 2011, the Fund has contributed more than \$723,415 to Thoroughbred aftercare facilities in New York State that are approved by the Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance (TAA). The fact that the Fund spends promotional dollars with entities that help retrain, rehome or offer sanctuary to ex-racehorses reflects the fact that the public increasingly wants to see that the industry respects horses at every stage of life.

The Fund also supported Cornell Cooperative Extension's outreach to young people through 4-H and farm tours to help the public gain appreciation for the farms and farm workers that make it possible to raise Thoroughbreds in the Empire State. Additionally, the Fund supported the National Museum of Racing and Hall of Fame outreach to the public and to children in particular.

The Fund's largest annual spend is a "sole source" contract with the Saratoga Springs-based trade and membership group New York Thoroughbred Breeders, Inc., which represents breeders in New York State. NYTB, Inc. is allowed to lobby lawmakers on behalf of the state's Thoroughbred industry.

NYTB also hosts a website (NYTBreeders.org) that compliments the Fund's website (NYBreds.com). The NYTB promotional write-up can be found on pages 97 to 102 of this report.

The Fund recognizes that, in addition to mailing out award checks, it has a responsibility to keep those who have already invested in Thoroughbreds informed about equine health issues and any changes in rules affecting NY-breds. Therefore, we communicate as directly as possible by posting important information on our website (NYBreds.com) and on the Fund's official Facebook page (NYBreds), as well as by sending out e-mail messages and including information with the award letters that accompany award checks.

Naturally, we also handle phone calls and e-mails on a daily basis, and the Executive Director meets directly with breeders at stallion shows and educational events.

HERE'S THE DEAL: When you purchase an in-foal broodmare at public auction for \$50,000 or more and bring her to New York within 15 days of the last date of the sale to foal in-state, that foal qualifies as a registered NY-bred. The mare may then leave to be bred out of state. She must return within 120 days (formerly 90 days) of her last cover and have a second New York foal. It's that simple!
